

# GOD SANCTIFIES US BY HIS GRACE

#### God declares what he requires of us and shows us our inability to do it

And behold, a lawyer stood up to put him to the test, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" He said to him, "What is written in the Law? How do you read it?" And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." And he said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live."

Whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of all of it.

#### We confess our sin and acknowledge that we are guilty of God's law

We use this time in God's presence to confess our sins and our need for God's grace, silently, personally before him alone. We invite you to join us in sorrow over your sin and joy in his grace and mercy in Jesus Christ

Luke 10 James 2

A full prayer of confession acknowledges that our sin is more than an isolated example of bad judgment; it is a way of life. Sin is our response to God-fleeing from him and running to other things. We confess that we are sinful people, and we live in need of a Savior.

# God declares our salvation—his mercy poured out richly on us in the Holy Spirit through Jesus Christ

When the kindness of God our Savior and his love for mankind appeared, he saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to his mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.


