Forgive us for trying to heal ourselves. Forgive us for neglecting your grace. Forgive us for looking to the good you have done within us as the payment of our hands for salvation. Forgive us, not for our name's sake, but for your name's sake, that you will be glorified as your grace is made perfect in our weakness through Jesus Christ. This we ask in his name. Amen.



As followers of Jesus Christ, living in this world— which some seek to control, and others view with despair—we declare with joy and trust: Our world belongs to God!




# God assures us of our security in his presence as his Spirit works in us as we celebrate the Lord's Supper




