

GOD SPEAKS WITH US BY HIS GRACE

¹⁰ Have we not all one Father? Has not one God created us? Why then are we faithless to one another, profaning the covenant of our fathers? ¹¹Judah has been faithless, and abomination has been committed in Israel and in Jerusalem. GOD STRENGTHENS US BY HIS GRACE

We celebrate the Lord's Supper to rest in his faithfulness to us guaranteed by the death of Jesus Christ for our sin

We celebrate God's free grace to us in Jesus Christ by observing the Lord's Supper each Sunday. We invite to the Lord's Table all those who are baptized followers of Jesus Christ under the authority of Christ and his body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking the cup, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for your salvation. If you have any doubts about your participation, please speak to one of the elders after the service.



A sacrament is a sign of participation in saving grace. It marks God's presence and work in those who seek him through Jesus Christ, enabling them to live boldly and faithfully for him.







We declare our desire to live faithfully in response to his faithfulness as we give our tithes, offerings, and lives

Elder: Where is the moral law summarily comprehended?

People: The moral law is summarily comprehended in the ten commandments.

Elder: What is the sum of the ten commandments?

People: The sum of the ten commandments is to love the Lord our God with all our

heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind; and

our neighbor as ourselves.

Elder: Which is the seventh commandment?

People: The seventh commandment is, Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Elder: What are the duties required in the seventh commandment?

People: The duties required in the seventh commandment are, chastity in body, mind, affections, words, and behavior; and the preservation of it in ourselves and others; watchfulness over the eyes and all the senses; temperance, keeping of chaste company, modesty in apparel; marriage by those that have not the gift of continency, conjugal love, and cohabitation; diligent labor in our callings; shunning all occasions of uncleanness, and

resisting temptations thereunto.

Elder: What are the sins forbidden in the seventh commandment?

People: The sins forbidden in the seventh commandment, besides the neglect of the duties required, are, adultery, fornication, rape, incest, sodomy, and all unnatural lusts; all unclean imaginations, thoughts, purposes, and affections; all corrupt or filthy communications, or listening thereunto; wanton looks, impudent or light behavior, immodest apparel; prohibiting of lawful, and dispensing with unlawful marriages; allowing, tolerating, keeping of stews, and resorting to them; entangling vows of single life, undue delay of marriage; having more wives or husbands than one at the same time; unjust divorce, or desertion; idleness, gluttony, drunkenness, unchaste company; lascivious songs, books, pictures, dancings, stage plays;

and all other provocations to, or acts of uncleanness, either in ourselves or

others.
